Korisnici: Osobe sa invaliditetom - smetnjama u razvoju i njihove porodice, ukupno 24 osobe

Opis projekta: Projektom je planirano organizovanje psihosocijalne podrške članovima i njihovim roditeljima-starateljima, radno okupacionu terapiju kroz aktivnosti u mini ogleđnom plasteniku baziranom na organskoj i ekološkoj proizvodnji. Psihosocijalna podrška osobama sa smetnjama u razvoju i porodicama osoba sa smetnjama u razvoju ima za cilj unapređenje psiho-socijalnog zdravlja kroz obezbeđivanje usluga ljudima koji preživljavaju kritični događaj. Na ovaj način se podiže svijest o emocionalnim reakcijama na pandemiju i identifikuju se osobe s psihosocijalnim teškoćama i procjenjuju se njihove potrebe za formalnijom intervencijom. Radno okupacionom terapijom u plasteniku, kod korisnika na kognitivnom području razvijaju se: koncentracija, pamćenje, strukturiranje, započinjanje i završavanje te planiranje. Ovom aktivnosti se povećava stepen sticanja kompetencija za samostalniji i svakodnevni život osoba sa smetnjama u razvoju u skladu sa svim mjerama zaštite za vreme pandemije.

Cilj ovog projekta je povećanje kvaliteta življenja i sticanje novih socijalnih vještina i rad na poboljšanju opšteg psihofizičkog stanja.

Uključeni korisnici će kroz radno okupacione i radno terapijske aktivnosti u prilagođenom plasteniku biti potaknuti na jačanje njihovog psihofizičkog i intelektualnog razvoja.

Location: Municipality of Bar

Beneficiaries: People with disabilities and their families, a total of 24 people

Project description: The project plans to organize psychosocial support to members and their parents-guardians, occupational therapy through activities in a mini greenhouse based on organic production. Psychosocial support for people with disabilities and families of people with disabilities aims to improve psychosocial health by providing services to people who survive a critical event. In this way, the awareness of emotional reactions to the pandemic is raised and people with psychosocial difficulties are identified and their needs for more formal intervention are assessed. With the occupational therapy in the greenhouse, the users develop the following cognitive traits: concentration, memory, structuring, beginning and ending, and planning. This activity increases the degree of acquisition of competencies for more independent and daily life of persons with disabilities in accordance with all protection measures during the pandemic.

The goal of this project is to increase the quality of life and acquire new social skills and work on improving the general psycho-physical wellbeing.

The users involved in this project will be encouraged to strengthen their psycho-physical and intellectual development through work and occupational therapy and through activities in the said greenhouse.



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
